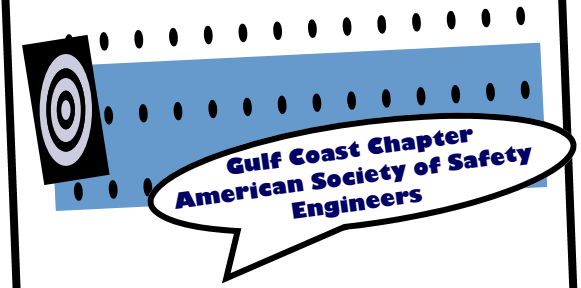

ASP Safety Fundamentals Preparation Workshop Monday-Wednesday, March 1-3, 2010

This is a three-day review course for those preparing for the Safety Fundamentals Examination, leading to the designation of Associate Safety Professional (ASP). This course is an excellent review for those desiring to:

1. Determine whether the participant is ready to attempt the Safety Fundamentals Examination
2. Identify areas where extra preparation is needed.
3. Become familiar with resources available to prepare for the exam.
4. Learn about certification requirements and scoring procedures.
5. Review content material in an informal environment utilizing a "testing" format including an opportunity for discussion.
6. Minimize "test shock" for those who have not taken an exam of this magnitude and importance for an extended period of time.

- AM Introduction, Review of Fundamentals Calculator, Algebra, and Trigonometry
- PM Review of Fundamentals—Physics, Probability, and Statistics

Day 2

CSP Comprehensive Exam Preparation Workshop Thursday-Saturday, March 4-6, 2010

This three-day course is designed to prepare individuals for the Comprehensive Examination leading to certification as a CSP. The course covers the four areas of the exam; engineering, management, information management and communications, and professional conduct and ethics. Pertinent reference materials are also discussed to allow students to focus their studies in specific areas prior to sitting for the exam. In particular, this course will:

1. Provide an outline for study for those beginning their preparation
